In addition to that, they work carefully with their staff to gather feedback and assess improvements. The resort employs four casual personnel, three cleaners, and a dedicated maintenance manager who takes care of Oceanside's every need. The couple have a close-knit relationship with the staff and they operate in a friendly atmosphere.

"We have fully self-contained villas. We are very hands-on so we always know what's actually happening within the property. We are always seek-






